## Interested in Becoming Catholic?

Many Catholics are born into Catholic families and gradually come to share in the full Sacramental life of the Church. Others, previously baptized in other Christian Churches or never baptized, become Catholic through a process known as The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Children over the age of seven participate in a modified process, The Rite of Christian Initiation of Children.

The Rites of Initiation of Adults and Children are the Catholic Church's way of initiating new members. We warmly welcome new members and attempt to provide an appropriate spiritual formation for each inquirer.



## Who may participate?

Those never baptized as Christians. Those baptized in another Christian faith tradition now interested in the Catholic tradition. Those baptized in the Catholic tradition whose sacramental reception is not complete. Children over the age of seven who have not received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Eucharist or Confirmation.
