

Stole of Remembrance

An invitation...

...to everyone in the parish to bring a special piece of cloth to become part of our "Stole of Remembrance." Each patch is given by a family or individual to remember a deceased relative or friend and should be placed in the basket near the baptismal font. The piece of cloth should be between 3" x 3" and 6" x 6," distinctive in color and design, and representative of your loved one.

Each piece of cloth will be cut and pieced together creating a respectful and visually pleasing design forming a "Stole of Remembrance." Following Adoration of the Cross on Good Friday, the stole will be draped upon the wooden cross uniting those who have died with Jesus, a reminder that they, like Jesus have the sure hope of resurrection.

Bring your fabric swatch to the parish office by noon on Friday, April 12th. Please understand that the stole will remain a permanent memorial; therefore, your contribution cannot be returned.
